Sermon: **Why Worry?**

Scripture: **Luke 12:22-27**

²² He said to his disciples, "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat, or about your body, what you will wear. ²³ For life is more than food, and the body more than clothing. ²⁵ And can any of you by worrying add a single hour to your span of life? ²⁶ If then you are not able to do so small a thing as that, why do you worry about the rest? ²⁷ Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not clothed like one of these. (NRSV)

Sermon Summary

Food, clothing, and housing are always essential items for the people since Adam and Eve left the Garden of Eden. As we need them today, people at Jesus' time also needed them. People followed Jesus because He fulfilled their needs. When He thought about the disciples who were following Him, He wanted to remind them to have firm faith in the Kingdom of Heaven because the spiritual salvation is more important than earthly happiness.

Jesus doesn't say we don't need food, clothing, and housing. He is saying that we should not worry about getting them because somehow, God will provide them as we work hard while trusting the Lord's promise. As we pray and ask, He will provide jobs to earn money for your needs. That is why we should not worry about it. If so, why do we worry?
