

**Sermon: Thanks for His Steadfast Love**

Scripture: **Psalm 136:23-26**

<sup>23</sup> It is he who remembered us in our low estate,  
for his steadfast love endures forever;  
<sup>24</sup> and rescued us from our foes,  
for his steadfast love endures forever;  
<sup>25</sup> who gives food to all flesh,  
for his steadfast love endures forever.

**Sermon Summary**

We have a reason to give thanks to the Lord, because our church is still intact and we keep up our faith through the Bible classes and prayer meetings on top of Sunday worships. It is not possible without the grace and steadfast love of the Lord, while non-believers cannot have the same blessings as we have.
