¹⁰ Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, so that they may also obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory.

¹¹ The saying is sure: If we have died with him, we will also live with him;

¹² if we endure, we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he will also deny us;

¹³ if we are faithless, he remains faithful - for he cannot deny himself. (NRSV)

Sermon Summary:

What will happen to our church when all of our church members have desires to be good spiritual leaders, as we have discussed so far? More members will be Christ-centered and experience spiritual revival and life transformation.

To achieve the goal of being Christ-centered, Apostle Paul suggests the following. It requires our endurance and efforts, but it is worthy because we can enjoy His presence and abundance in every part of our life.

1. Endure everything for the sake of other believers in order to guide them to Christ
2. Give up worldly desires; Instead, have a desire to live with Him
3. Be faithful to the Lord by denying our own ego

The Institution of the Lord's Supper (1 Corinthians 11:23-26)

²³ For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took a loaf of bread, ²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." ²⁵ In the same way he took the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." ²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.
