Sermon: **He Is with Us**

Scripture: **Luke 24:36-39**

<sup>36</sup> While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." <sup>37</sup> They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost. <sup>38</sup> He said to them, "Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? <sup>39</sup> Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." (NRSV)

***Sermon Summary:***

After the Lord died on the cross helplessly, the disciples were very disappointed and totally lost and struggling with fear. Suddenly, Jesus showed up and said, "Peace be with you." It was more than a surprise. They couldn't believe what they saw and heard. Their hopeless heart was suddenly full of joy and peace.

Our Lord wants His faithful disciples to have no more doubts but have faith in Him. He is telling the same message to all His followers. No more fear of death but to have hope and joy in Him. What does this mean to us, and how can we have that?
