***Call to Worship in unison:**

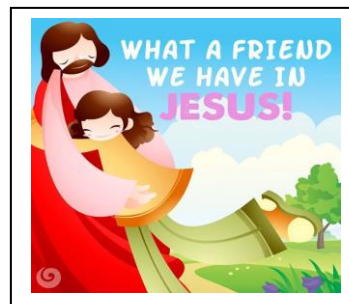
